Review your Program Completion Status

You can review your Program Completion Application Status (this is your application to graduate) on this page. You may have to scroll right to see more details depending on the size of your browser screen.

- If your graduation application has been submitted successfully, the fourth column of your Program Completion Application Status table will be "Pending Completion" until your degree has been conferred. After your degree conferral, the status will change to "Complete".
- The fifth column of your Program Completion Application Status table will update automatically based on the stage of your graduation application. For example, after you submit your Program Completion Application, the status will change to "Applied for Completion".
