

About transfer credit

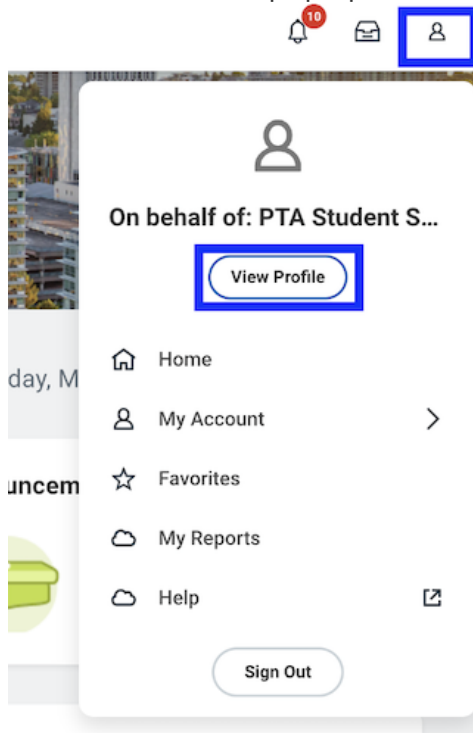
For your graduate program you will only have access to the “Transfer Credit” tab in Workday if you have been awarded transfer credits from another institution.

If you have received transfer credits from another UBC program these will not show up on your Workday Record or transcripts. However, you will receive a confirmation email once these credits are approved and this info will be used by G+PS to ensure you meet the minimum credit requirements when closing your program.

How to check your transfer credit

First, go to your profile in Workday


1. Log into your Workday account at myworkday.ubc.ca.
2. On the Workday home screen, click your user icon in the top right corner.
3. Click the “View Profile” button in the pop up menu.



Next, go to your transfer credit

1. Once you're in your profile, click the “Academics” tab in the left menu.
2. In the “Academics” page, click the “Transfer Credit” tab in the top menu. You will only see this tab in the menu if you have been awarded transfer credit.
